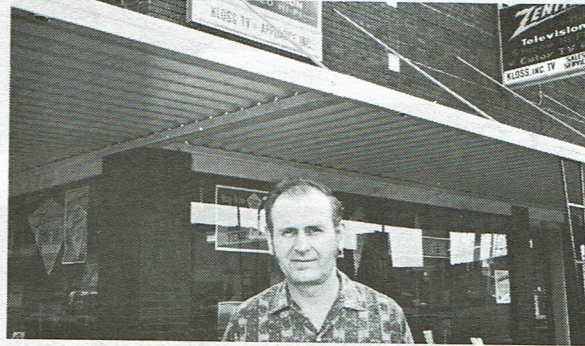


## 35 Years in Service to Merrill

At that time he had four lines of television; Admiral, Motorola, Storm & Carlson and Zenith and Norge home appliances. In 1966 when color T.V. began to sell in this area, the business moved to its present location because of expansion reasons. The company's employment increased from two people in early years to five now, with Mr. George Wanless as manager.
