

Eagles are people helping people



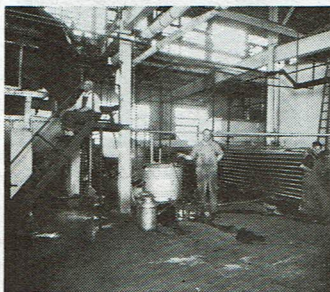
Merrill's Eagles auxiliary, instituted in November, 1951 is one of the top ranking contributors for state and national charitable funds.

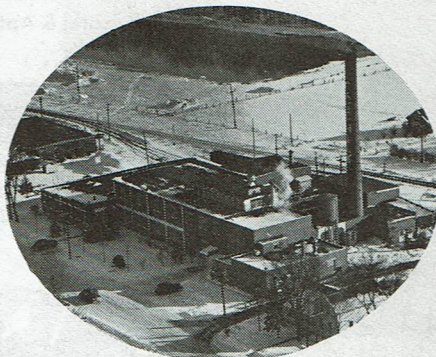

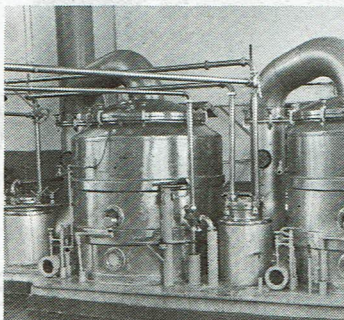

The Page Milk Company in Merrill began on November 1, 1925. The organization of the original canned milk plant was in 1865 in Switzerland by Charles A. Page.

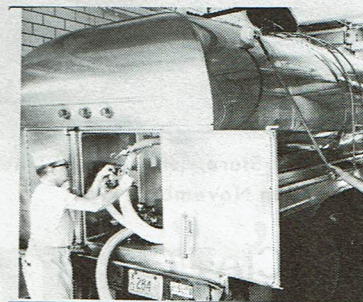
